Punch Cards: Each card has 10 Punches on the card. You can purchase daycare punch cards at the Field House front desk during business hours.

Membership Packages: Childcare is included in the Bronze Membership Packages and Platinum Membership Packages. This is available in both Single and Family options.

Policies and Procedures

- Childcare is available for children ages 6 months and up.
- A parent/guardian will not be able to leave the Recreation Center while their child is in drop-off daycare.
- A maximum of 2 hours in childcare is allowed per child.
- The parent who drops the child off must be the parent picking up.
- Pacifiers and comfort items such as blankets and stuffed animals are permitted and must be labeled.
- No pre-made bottles or toys from home are allowed in the childcare area.
- Sippy cups, with water only are permitted and must be labeled. No juice or milk.
- Parents/guardians will be notified to change diaper. Staff will not be responsible to change diapers.
- Parents will be notified if a child cannot be comforted from crying after 15 minutes.
- In order to ensure that safety of the children, parents must abide by our Sick Child Policy. Children who exhibit symptoms described in our exclusion policy will be asked to leave.

Sick Child Policy

Please refer to the list if you are unsure of our Sick Child policy.

- If your child has a temperature over 101 degrees, and exhibits behavior changes or other signs that your child does not feel well enough to participate comfortably in the daily activities. Please keep your child home until his/her behavior returns to normal.
- If your child has had diarrhea in the past 24 hours, keep your child at home until the child has been diarrhea-free for 24 hours or stools are formed enough that they are contained in the diaper. Potty trained children should be accident-free for one day.
- If your child is vomiting, please keep your child home for up to 24 hours after the vomiting has ended.
- If your child has a yellow runny nose, accompanied by fever and crankiness or difficulty breathing, please keep your child home until the child is fever free.
- If your child is experiencing itchy, watery eyes (often symptoms of pink eye), please keep your child at home until the condition has been evaluated and treatment has begun.
- If your child is exhibiting an unexplained skin rash, please keep your child home until the condition has been evaluated and treated.
- As parents, use your best judgment in determining your child's health. Please take your child seriously when he/she says they are not feeling well.

You, as the parents, are ultimately responsible for determining your child's ability to actively participate in the daily activities in the drop in day care. While we sympathize with the needs of each parent and their child, we must provide a healthy environment for the other children in the day care. A sick child often needs special one-on-one attention. It is difficult for a staff member to take time away from well children to devote special attention to a sick child.

We have instituted this policy based on the wishes and opinions of our parents to avoid any confusion over the health and well being of our children. The staff and the Victoria Recreation Center appreciates your compliance with our Sick Child Policy. As always, feel free to call if you are uncertain about your child's condition. As a general rule, if your child is not up to par due to illness, please keep your child at home.
